

2026 Dominion Any Car Division Rules

General Car Rules 1-1-2026

Must have Valid State Driver's License

1. Any 2 or 4 door car. 4cyl and 6 cyl can be FWD or RWD. V8 cars must be RWD. 4 cyl and 6 cyl max curb weight 3,400 lbs. V8 max curb weight 4,000 lbs. **(NO CHEVROLET CORVETTES, ALL YEARS)**

1.A. Pick up's- 2-wheel RWD only. Max curb weight 3,600 lbs.

1.B. No convertibles. T-tops and sunroofs must be replaced with metal.

2. Cars/ Trucks must be strictly stock with **NO** modifications. Must run factory engine and transmission with factory mounts. This includes all engine components, drive train, suspension, ignition system, cooling system, and axles. Exhaust should maintain stock appearance and muffler insert is required may have aftermarket air cleaner.

3. No chopping, channeling, bracing or shortening of frame allowed **(door plates may be used for safety only)**. No exceptions. A full steel body must always remain original and intact. No rub rails or sharp edges on the outside of the body.

4. Passenger tires only. Wheels and tires must be of the same size on all four corners. The right front wheel **MUST** be reinforced to prevent its loss during the race. Plating washer and/or oversized nuts must be used. Tire size: any size original stock rim is acceptable. No altering tire in any way. No mud or snow tires (i.e. those designed specifically for mud or snow. Regular road tires that say "M&S" are acceptable). No bias ply tires allowed. No pipes or protectors welded over the tire valve stem.

5. No turbos or superchargers allowed. One stock Carburetor (2 or 4 Barrel) or fuel injection only.

6. Batteries must be relocated in a secure and fastened covered plastic or rubber container or must be in their original position under the hood and securely fastened.

7. Hoods and deck lids must have original hinges or pins/chains keeping them in place or they must be removed.

8. The stock steel floor pan, firewall, trunk floor, and wheel wells must be retained.

9. All cars must have a windshield or if a windshield is removed, the car must have bracing over the windshield area covered with mesh. All other glass and trim should be removed (but at track discretion) including headlights and taillights. No broken glass allowed in the car. Lexan windshield permitted.

10. Must have steering wheel, steering column, and pedals in stock position (removable steering wheel permitted).

11. Car interior must be removed in the driver and passenger areas. Dash console can be left in place.

12. Only racing seats are allowed.

13. No passengers allowed.
14. The driver's door can be welded, chained, locked, or bolted shut. If the driver's door comes open, the car will be black flagged and parked for that race.
15. Bumpers must be chained or reinforced to frame to keep it from dropping onto the track. Must have stock bumper covers in place.
16. 300 tread wear tires or higher (**NO RACING TIRES**).
17. Window nets are mandatory.
18. Max camber on front tires is 2 degrees, rear must be stock 0 degrees.

Safety

1. Fire Suit and gloves required. Neck collar or head restraint highly recommended.
2. Helmet SA2015 rating or newer required and in good operable condition.
3. Racing type seat belt and harness required.
4. Roll cage: No roll cage allowed forward of the firewall or rear of the passenger area. Minimum cage for **ANY CAR CLASS** is 1.50-inch diameter and .095 thickness. The cage must be welded on 6x6 .25 plates (see illustration 1).
5. Extra bracing may be installed as a safety feature only and may not reinforce the body or frame or alter the geometry of the car. Roll bar installation is subject to inspection and will be closely scrutinized.
6. Gas tanks located above or in front of the rear axle do not have to be relocated. All others must be replaced with a fuel cell (maximum of 12 gallons) or boat tank (maximum of 6.6 gallons). The fuel cell/boat tank must be secured and located in the front of the trunk. The fuel line must exit from the top or side of the fuel cell/boat tank. A complete firewall must seal the trunk area from the driver's compartment if the fuel tank is placed in the trunk. No gas line in driver's compartment.
7. All airbags must be removed from cars/trucks.

Loose Your Ride Rule

Any driver after competing in the third race of the season and is in the top three in points may use the loose your ride rule on another driver in the top three in points. The driver using this rule **MUST**:

1. Within 15 minutes of the checkered flag, notify the tech official in writing along with \$4,000 in cash of the car that they are using the loose your ride rule against.
2. The rule can only be used once by a driver during the race season and the driver it is being used against can only have it done to them once during the season by anyone.
3. The driver that the loose your ride rule used against will receive \$3,500 and they cannot race that car the rest of the season. The car can be raced by someone else.

Miscellaneous

1. Mascots, decorating cars, advertising, nicknames, cartoons, etc. are encouraged. Mascots and decorations must be secured to not fall off on the track while racing.
2. No suggestive language, symbols, or numbers allowed on any car. Anything on the care in bad taste will result in disqualification.
3. Your car number should be painted on both sides of the car in contrasting colors at least 18 inches high and 5 inches wide, It must be legible and fill the entire door space. If you don't have a legible number, you will not be scored.
4. Every competitor is required to run a transponder on their car. Transponders are available for rent from the track at each event. You may also bring your own if it works with our system at no cost to you.
5. Effective 5/5/2021, if you move your ANYCAR up into any other division (example, UCAR, Mini-Mod) you will not be allowed to move it back to the Anycar division.
